

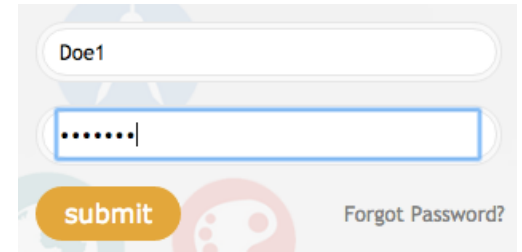
Using Empower Parent Portal

In your browser, go to <http://empower.link75.org>.

Click the **Username** field and type in your username as it appears in the message you received from the school principal.

Click the **Password** field and type in your password as it appears in the message you received from the school principal.

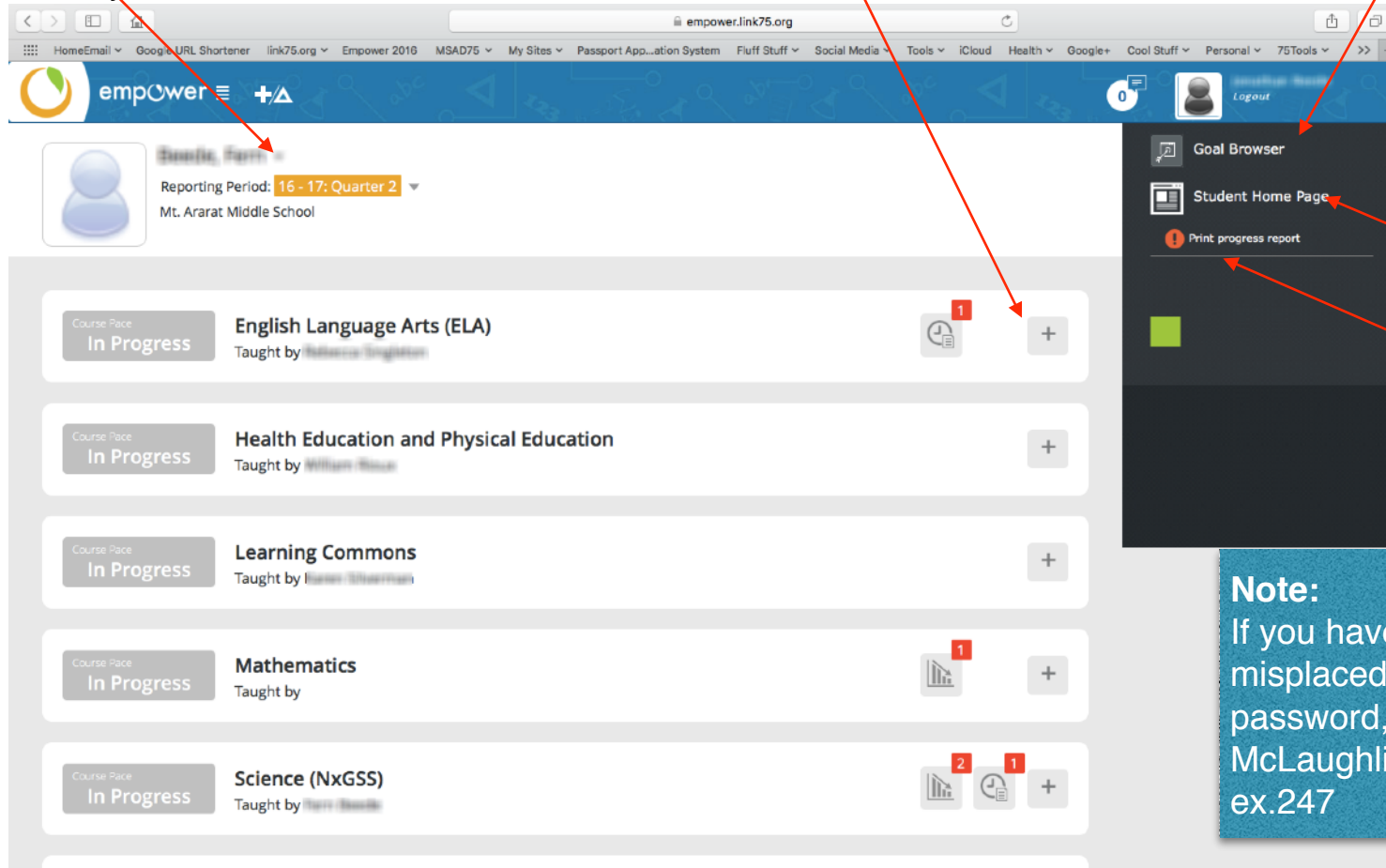
Click the orange **submit** button.
