Running a Report on Your Students

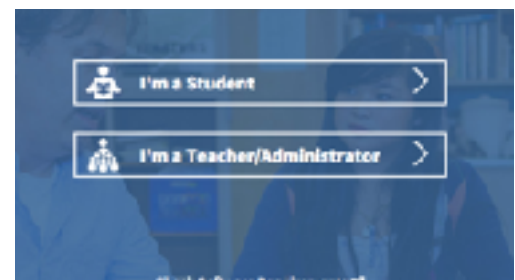
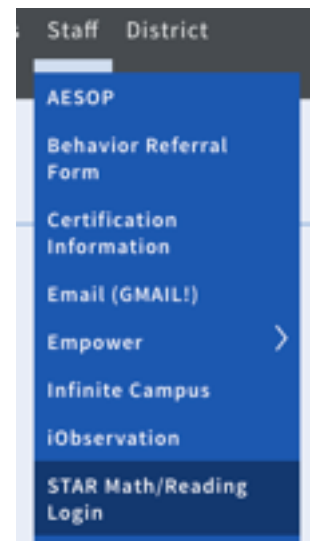
1. Open a browser on your device.

Go to the MAMS website.

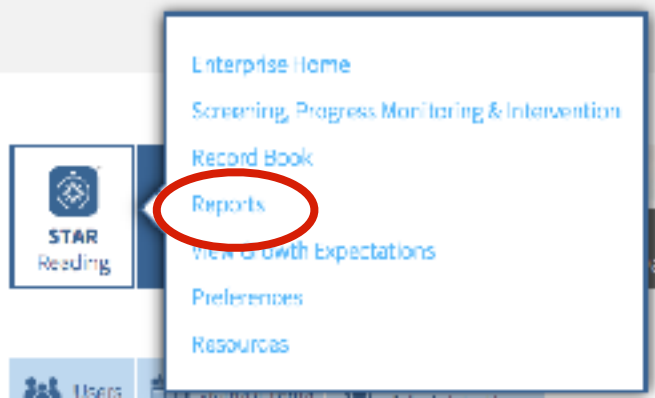
Hover your cursor arrow over the Staff menu and click on STAR Reading/Math Login at the bottom of the menu.

2. Click Log in as a Teacher/Administrator.

Use your username that is first initial last name. ex. Jsmith for John Smith. You will use the pw you set up recently during your initial log in.



2. On the Home page, select either the **STAR Reading** or **STAR Math** and a window will appear. Click on **Reports**.



3. A window with a list of various reports will appear. I would recommend you use **Summary** that is found at the bottom of the **Frequently Used Reports** list.

Click on a report name to view the report with default settings.

Reports	Description
Diagnostic	Presents diagnostic and skill information for an individual student.
Growth	Shows growth for a group of students over time, with emphasis on SLP—students.
Instructional Planning - Class	Provides an at-a-glance view of class or group instruction based on most re-
Instructional Planning - Student	Provides an at-a-glance view of individualized instruction based on most re-
Screening	Displays students' placement classification based on STAR scores.
Student Progress Monitoring	Displays an individual student's progress toward goal.
Summary	Summarizes student test results for a specific date range.

Area of Progress	Shows student progress over a school year.
Growth Proficiency Chart	Plots Student Growth Percentiles (SGP) and proficiency on a quarterly basis. Comp-
Longitudinal	Shows growth over multiple years.
Parent - English	Presents informational letters in English for parents and guardians.
Parent - Spanish	Presents informational letters in Spanish for parents and guardians.
Reading Range	Provides reading range information for each student.
State Performance - Class	Displays the percent of students on the pathway to proficiency on the MEA Test. Pe-
State Performance - Student	Displays a student's pathway to proficiency on the MEA Test. Proficiency levels are d-
State Standards - Class	Groups students by estimated mastery of State Standards or Common Core State
State Standards - District	Displays mastery of state standards by classroom over state standards for group-
State Standards - Student	Displays a student's mastery of state standards as compared to the state standard
Time Interval	Shows students who have and haven't entered during a specific time range.
